Clay was applied with consistency.

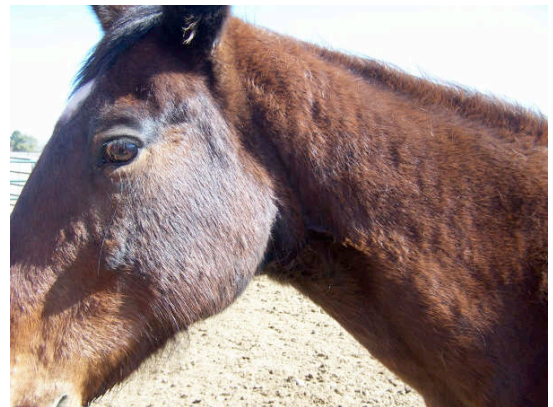
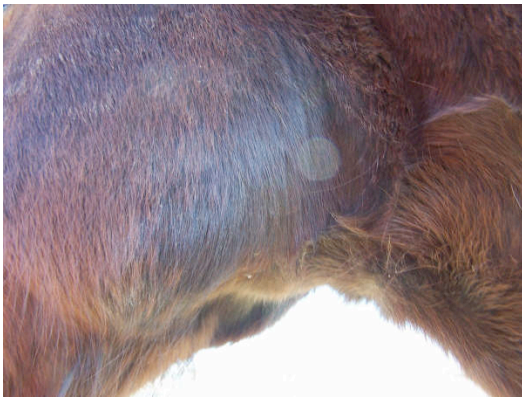
A major key to successful healing.
